

# Sustainable Urban Development Geographical Information Science

The University of Washington Tacoma Campus is an urban centered institution where building styles mimic turn of the century industrial warehouses. The campus ascends 3 levels in a northwesterly direction starting from 21st Street and Pacific Avenue and is in operation through 27 unique buildings. LiDAR point cloud data was extracted using zonal statistics of inverse distance weighted events in ArcMap and extruded into 3D shapes with ArcScene to provide a scaled representation of campus environment. Relative perceived heights are given as experienced through haste exploration and recollection of time spent on campus from 2017 – 2020.
